Results - Safe and Drug-Free Prevention Survey

Title IV funding, which supported the Safe and Drug-Free Schools initiative, ended at the conclusion of the 2009-2010 school year. A yearly practice as a part of that program has been to conduct a survey of significant groups associated with the schools to assess the impact of the Safe and Drug-Free program. This annual survey was conducted in the spring of 2014. The groups who participated in the survey included students, building administrators, teachers and parents.
