Health Care Information Forms for Individuals (1095-C Form)

[Form 1095-C](#) - *Employer-Provided Health Insurance Offer and Coverage*. This form will be sent to all full-time employees and individuals that were covered under the TRS ActiveCare medical plan. The form will contain information about what coverage was offered and whether coverage was elected or declined by you and other members of your family.

How will I receive this form?

Just as you receive your W-2 form, Klein ISD will mail (or hand deliver) these forms to you or you can consent to electronic delivery. You can go to: [Employee Access \(https://eac.kleinisd.net/EAC51/Login.aspx\)](https://eac.kleinisd.net/EAC51/Login.aspx) and elect to have electronic delivery or do nothing, and we will mail your 1095-C the week of February 20th.

Do I Submit the Form 1095-C with my tax return?

No! Although you may use the information on the form to help complete your tax return, the form should not be attached to your return or sent to the IRS. You should keep the forms for your records with your other important tax documents.

Must I wait to file until I receive this form?

No! While the information on these forms may assist in preparing a return, they are not required. Like last year, taxpayers can prepare and file their returns using other information about their health insurance. You should not attach any of these forms to your tax return.

When will I receive this, 1095-C, health care tax form?

The Federal deadline has been extended to March 2, 2017. You can go to the KISD Employee Access Center (<https://eac.kleinisd.net/EAC51/Login.aspx>), elect to receive your 1095-C electronically, and print it yourself.

Klein ISD, in compliance with the Affordable Care Act, will provide a form that gives you information about the health care coverage that you had or were offered during the previous calendar year. Much like the Form W-2, which provides income information, this new health care form provides information that may help you when completing your individual income tax return. **However, you do NOT send in this form with your taxes.** Also, just like Forms W-2 and 1099, this health information will be provided to the IRS.
