

SPECIAL REPORT on the BUILDING PROGRAM April 2018

The information in this special report is presented for study purposes only. All projections of enrollment and building requirements are tentative and subject to modifications semi-annually. All enrollment figures for future years should be considered as mid-points in a range of approximately 10 percent. The tables and figures have been designed to be self-explanatory.

These data provide a reasonable basis for the administration's forecast. However, some assumptions inevitably will not materialize and unanticipated events and circumstances may occur. Therefore, the actual enrollment figures during the forecast period will differ from those shown in this booklet and the differences may be material.

BUILDING PROGRAM REPORT- EXECUTIVE SUMMARY-APRIL 2018

- On May 9, 2015, voters approved the authorization of \$498.1 million in bonds to meet the district's building program requirements for approximately 5 years. The following sales have been conducted since approval:
 - June 2015, \$171.0 million was sold and \$62.6 million was refunded, totaling \$224.6 million, which included the remaining \$47.8 million from the 2008 authorization;
 - January 2017, \$171 million
 - January 2018, \$93 million
- A major source of local funding for school districts is ad valorem taxes levied against the local tax base. The former provision of the Education Code, Section 45.003, which limited the M&O tax rate to \$1.50 per \$100 of taxable assessed value, was replaced with a formula using the state compression percentage. The 2006-07 tax rate was reduced by twelve (12) cents from the previous year for a total of \$1.58 per \$100 of valuation due to changes enacted during the 79th special session of the Texas Legislature (HB 1), and reduced further to \$1.26 per \$100 of valuation for 2007. A district that adopted a \$1.50 M&O rate in 2005 was compressed to \$1.00 in 2008 with a maximum cap thereafter of \$1.17 per \$100 of valuation. The District's 2009-10 rollback calculation was based on: 2005 Adopted Tax Rate of \$1.50 x .6667 = \$1.00 Maintenance & Operations + .04 Optional (discussed below) + .32 Debt Service = \$1.36. The adopted 2015-16 tax rate is \$1.04 Maintenance & Operations plus \$.37 Debt Service for a total of \$1.41.
- During the 2006-07 and the 2007-08 fiscal years, districts could generate additional local funds by raising their M&O tax rate by \$0.04 above the compressed tax rates without voter approval. Such amounts generated equalized funding dollars from the State under the Tier Two program. For fiscal year 2008-09 and thereafter, districts may increase their tax rate by an additional two cents to \$1.06, and receive state equalization funds for such taxing effort, so long as the voters approve the increase. The remaining eleven (\$.11) cents to the maximum M&O cap of \$1.17 are not equalized and require voter approval. The governing body of a school district cannot adopt an annual tax rate that exceeds the District's "rollback tax rate" without submitting such proposed tax rate to the voters in a Tax Rate Election (TRE).
- The greatest need for classrooms due to student enrollment growth into the near future continues to be expected along FM 2920 and Huffsmith-Kohrville to the District's northernmost boundary. Since 2004, Klein ISD has opened fifteen (15) new campuses and added large additions at Klein Forest, Klein Oak, and Klein Collins High Schools due to growth and program needs. Kreinhop Elementary and McDougle Elementary opened in 2004. Metzler Elementary opened in 2005. Benignus Elementary opened in the WindRose subdivision in August 2006, and was the first elementary school designed using the 2004 Findings and Directions. The instructional addition to Klein Forest High School and the VISTAS High School Program also opened for the 2006-07 school year. Krimmel Intermediate, located on FM 2920 north of WindRose, and Frank Elementary, located in the northern part of the Gleannloch Farms subdivision, opened in 2007. Mueller Elementary School, which opened in 2009, was the first new facility funded from the 2008 bond authorization. Ulrich Intermediate School opened in August 2010 along Spring-Cypress Road, west of the Gleannloch Farms subdivision. Blackshear Elementary opened in August 2011 and Zwink Elementary opened in August 2012. Grace England Early Childhood and Pre-K Center also opened in August 2012. Bernshausen Elementary opened in August 2013. French Elementary opened in August 2015, and Mahaffey Elementary opened in August 2016, representing our 31st elementary campus. Klein Cain High School opened in August 2017 and Hofius Intermediate (tenth intermediate school) is under construction and scheduled to open in

August 2018. The 33rd elementary school is set begin construction in April 2018 and open in August 2019.

- In 2008, the District opened the Network Operations Center (NOC), located behind Central Office on Spring Cypress Road, and the new Police Department building, located on Louetta between Klein High School and Kleb Intermediate School. In 2009, the district completed the new Annex facility to house the Therapeutic Education Program and Disciplinary Alternative Education Program. The South Transportation Center (STC), serving campuses south of FM 1960, opened in January 2010. The Klein Multipurpose Center opened in August 2012.
- At the end of the first semester of the 2017-18 school year, in December 2017, 53,184 students were enrolled. The percentages of students at each instructional level are expected to be approximately as follows:

46% Grades PK – 5

23% Grades 6 – 8

31% Grades 9 – 12

• The long-range estimate of pupil density per square mile is expected to be approximately 740 students. Pupil density per square mile is based on an enrollment that would stabilize after a peak in excess of 65,000 students. Consequently, the total new schools needed by category, presuming the existing school capacities are retained, would be as follows:



 Based on the district's current total of forty-six (46) schools, the KISD has reached approximately eighty-eight percent (88%) of its permanent classroom facility requirements. By careful long-range planning the KISD can minimize the need to close schools after we reach our maximum enrollment and begin to decline in pupil population. Our prudent utilization of transportable facilities will continue to save the Klein ISD millions of tax dollars.







HOW SCHOOL TAXES ARE CALCULATED

- 1. Beginning in January 1984, a central taxing authority established values for all properties in Harris County. Each school district sets only the tax rate.
- 2. A home or property is placed on the tax rolls at 100 percent of market value.
- 3. In the summer of 1991 the Harris County Education District (HCED), a newly founded taxing entity, became operational. They set their tax rate at \$0.912 for 1992. This rate was added to the amount set by each local district in Harris County. However, the two numbers could only be combined when taxes were placed on non-residential property because of the 20% Homestead exemption. The Texas Legislature eliminated the county education district concept in 1993.

2017–18 Klein ISD (\$1.43)

A tax rate at \$1.43 would calculate as follows based on \$1.04 M & O and \$0.39 Debt Service:

Among the components of successful elections are long-range planning, the perception of a need by the parents, an informed electorate, and a construction program that reflects a reasonable approach to meet the new construction and remodeling/renovation requirements of a school district growing in student enrollment. That was how it worked in the 1970's, 1980's, 1990's, 2004, 2008 and 2015.

Klein School District: A Brief History

The County Board of Education on June 7, 1928, grouped into Rural School district #1, Common School Districts #1, #2, #3, #9, and #47.

The County Board of Education on October 2, 1928, ordered the grouping of school Districts in Harris County into High School Districts.

The County Board of Education in June, 1928, found that the scholastics of elementary schools in Common School Districts #1, #2, #3, #9, and #47 to be:

District #1	-	62
District #2	-	77
District #3	-	103
District #9	-	79
District #47	-	29
Total enrollmer	nt :	350

The County Board stated:

"Whereas, proper high school facilities for the pupils attending the elementary schools in the Common School Districts named above are not available and not readily accessible to the pupils in said districts and it is in the best interest of the pupils in said districts that Common School Districts be grouped into a Rural High School District."

The Board found the five (5) districts would be composed of an area 77 square miles and there existed no bounded indebtedness except in District #9 in the sum of \$3,000.

The County Board of Education on May 22, 1930, passed orders reestablishing Rural High School District #1.

On December 7, 1934, the County Board of Education entered an order approving classification of Rural High School District #1 as a four (4) year high school.

On February 10, 1938, the County Board of Education issued an order for an election on February 26, 1938, to determine whether Rural School District No. 1 be incorporated as an Independent School District.

On March 3, 1938, the County Board of Education issued an order that Rural High School District #1 incorporated as the Klein Independent School District.
